Language use is paramount to promote healing in ceremonies and cultural norms. Reformation and Reconciliation ministry will be collaborated with Jan Brown of Spirit Works. Other areas of ministry will address covid, substance abuse, and healing. St. Andrews Owens Project will assist with computers to educate young people in isolated areas. Deputies going to General Convention involve changes; Ruth Johnson and Ashley Hubbard will attend as replacements. Ruth Johnson knows a lot of history and was nominated by Rev. Eaton and seconded by Rev. Joe Hubbard. A question arose if a special session was done to welcome Ruth. A special meeting was held on Thursday and Ruth needs to register to attend General Convention.
